## ORGANISATION

EARLALL – European Association of Regional and Local Authorities for Lifelong Learning – is an international non-profit association established in 2001. It is managed by a Board and a General Assembly and today represents 23 members, among Regional and Local Authorities, whose aims are to cooperate and raise the role and visibility of Regional and Local Authorities in the field of Lifelong Learning at the European level.

The members are actively involved in the life of the organisation through the General Assembly – which is held twice a year in Brussels or in a member body location – technical groups specialised in particular issues, thematic seminars and other events to take forward joint projects.



## VISION AND OBJECTIVES

Lifelong Learning has a crucial role in achieving the strategic objectives the European Union has had for the past ten years, and for the next ten years as well. In this framework, EARLALL believes that Regions and Local Authorities have a privileged role in designing and implementing strategies on Lifelong Learning since they are in direct contact with citizens, educational institutions and business environment.

EARLALL has been constituted with three main objectives:

- Seeking to influence EU policies relevant for life-long learning and increasing the role of the Regions in the field;
- Facilitating the cooperation between its members in order to promote the exchange of experiences and best practice between European regional and local authorities;
- Encouraging the development of joint projects – supported by EU funding programmes.
