

Apprenticeships: State of Play

- Variety of apprenticeship-type schemes
- Apprenticeship supply (2009): 9,4 mn places
- Diverse perception of VET studies
- Increased attention to positive employment outcomes EU 27 Average 3.7%

- Alternation: company-based learning and school education?






Challenges:

- Strong partnerships between Ministries
- Quality of the schemes e.g. link to education system
- Link to labour market needs: role of Social Partners
- Monitoring and Evaluation
- Targeting drop-outs versus employers' needs
- Adapted to individuals versus institutional VET cycles
- Long-term approach
- Funding
