Council Declaration on the Alliance 15 October 2013

- Comprehensive approach combining education, training and employment measures
- Establishment of common guiding principles
- MSs commitments





Member States' commitments (1)

- All MSs, apart from CY, EL, FR, IT, MT, PT and SE, responded
- 3 clusters of responses:
 - Introducing dual principles in formal VET, enhancing the WBL dimension in VET
 - Expanding existing apprenticeships
 - Fine-tuning in well-established apprenticeship schemes



Member States' commitments - Highlights

- RO: Share of WBL: 60% 1st year, 75% 2nd year (IVET programme)
- FI: Reform framed in Youth Guarantee
- LT: Double WBL-based VET by 2020



Member States' commitments (3)

What we would like to see:

- Concrete info on:
 - Length on (new) apprenticeship programmes
 - Targeted share of WBL and theoretical learning
 - Indicators, Timeline
 - Budget
 - Link to Youth Guarantee
 - Link to CSR





Apprenticeship and Youth Guarantee (YG)

 One out of four YG options (employment, continued education, an apprenticeship or traineeship)

 22 Youth Guarantee plans submitted (20 MS eligible for funding under the Youth Employment Initiative, plus AT and MT)

Opportunities for Apprenticeships



Apprentices explicitely mentioned as eligible participants (p. 23 ERA+ Guide)

One VET priority is "developing partnerships between education and employment (in particular companies and social partners)" (p. 27)



KA-1 Mobility for VET learners

VET traineeship abroad from 2 weeks to 12 months:

- placement in a workplace
- quality framework + learning agreement
- learning outcomes validated + recognised at institutional level





KA-1 Mobility for VET learners

- recently qualified can also participate (within 1 year after)
- individuals cannot apply directly for a grant
- abroad for >1 month: grant for linguistic preparation
- national VET consortia can apply (min. 3 VET organisations)





KA-2 Strategic Partnerships in VET

Aims inter alia:

- increasing labour market-relevance of learning provision & qualifications
- involvement of local & regional authorities in the qualitative development of edu & train



KA-2 Strategic Partnerships in VET

Eligible organisations inter alia:

- enterprises
- inter-company training centres
- companies providing shared training (collaborative training)

Strategic Partnerships can include long-term training assignments





KA-2 Sector Skills Alliances

Aims inter alia:

- responsiveness of IVET and CVT to sectorspecific labour market needs
- notably at local & regional levels
- cooperation VET & labour market integrating work-based learning

Focus on WBL, apply knowledge in practical projects and "real life" workplace situations are mentioned

and Culture



KA-2 Sector Skills Alliances

Eligible organisations inter alia:

- enterprises
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- companies providing apprenticeships or shared training (collaborative training)





KA-3 Policy Support

Apprenticeship call:

- for national authorities
- deadline set for 26 June 2014
- contribute to national reforms, building highquality apprenticeship schemes
- social partners, VET schools, individual companies important for quality of proposals
