- Recession then public spending cuts

Key Statistics: Population – 3,006,430
Employment rate – 67.7%
Public sector employment - 11.2%
Unemployment - 8.4%
Youth unemployment – 22.5%
Students in Further Education - 4.2% less


#### **Response Measures**



- ProAct (ESF)
  - Short term intervention
- ReAct II (ESF)
  - 2 level redundancy response
- Financial Analysis
  - Focus on front line services

#### **Financial Analysis**





Only 44% of all education funding directly delivers learning

Simplify management arrangements and move more resource to front line delivery

# Forward Policy Imperatives Wales



- Literacy, numeracy, and tackling link between low attainment and socioeconomic status
- Funding 1% above the baseline
- Institutional transformation
- Qualifications review
- Tackling exclusion
