

Background of Inclusion and growth into labour market in Styria

- Aspects of Styrian "philosophy, policy and programmes"
- Youth policy and inclusion is an "long-term" issue, not like a "switch"
- Base is inclusive work at the interfaces between school and enterprises since the early 1990'
- Styria was and is pioneer in transition and interface activities school and world of work
- The significant developments in youth employment are clearly caused by several measures





Effective measures for youth policies in Styria

- Qualification and Employment Programme Styria
- Territorial employment contracts in the subregions
- Active pioneer role in promoting national developments – like in "prevocational school"
- Innovative concepts for supporting transiton processes school, VET and Work (e.g. career catching councellors)
- Offering the region Styria for piloting national programmes, like Youth coaching, apprenticeship coaching, fit for work etc..





Consequences for Inclusion and growth into labour market

- To be aware of the attitude of all relevant actors – essential is the willingness of entrepreneurs to open the doors for youth
- Open access to guidance for all who need in all phases who need
- Special programmes like "inclusive VET" at national and regional level
- Communication, co-operation and co-ordination between all relevant actors
- Using all opportunities at local, regional, provincial and national level – respecting the European dimension as well as the very individual dimension of inclusion and employment
