# Regione Toscana

- Toscana's complex sectoral mobility program, e.g. including formal and non-formal learning
- Target sectors: sustainable tourism / catering / shipbuilding+harbor logistics
- two dimensional program:

A actions necessary to define the goals of the cooperation agreement with foreign partners

B four types of instruments, e.g. cooperation between businesses, social partners, mobility to support university students in work experience abroad

- involve all stakeholders, e.g. businesses; students, workers, social partners
- overall funding €1.500.000

# Provincia Livorno Sviluppo

- transnational mobility important, especially in a sectoral approach
   (→ Toscana)
- 3 projects approved by Toscana government for Livorno
- involve all stakeholders, e.g. Businesses, workers, social partners
- instruments to enhance mobility, e.g. Workshops + networks
- Support efforts of companies to become more international
- develop tourism by qualifying employees, e.g. through "study visits abroad"
- challenge: convince employees and employers to participate

Junta de Andalucia

- Andalusia Educative Model
- Problem: current economic crisis (short-term?)
- •- low qualifications of cotizens compared to rest of Europe, especially "medium qualifications"
- involve all stakeholders, e.g. workers, employers, social partners,
- Develop flexible and versatile training system
- recognize qualifications through EQVET
- Andalusia developed several instruments, e.g. Integrated information and career guidance system, vocational training centers and VET networks
- active participation in LLL action program, e.g. Leonardo, Erasmus
- challenges: budget, e.g. ESF allocation / Recognition of nonformal and informal learning / awareness for mobility
