





Adult Learning post-2020

Prepare report to the Council on the EU on Upskilling Pathways

Definine new priorities for adult learning, that complement the European Educaton Area, and guide the adult education strand of Erasmus

Develop non-formal learning and skills for life to complement upskilling and reskilling for work, which will be taken forward through the VET Recommendation, & support UN Sustainable Development Goal 4

Continue the work of National Coordinators for Adult Learning and Adult Learning Working Group as part of the wider European cooperation in education and training



Role of apprenticeships

40% of Europe's employers can't find people with the right skills to fill their vacancies.

46% of companies indicate that vocational skills are the most important for future development

80% of apprentices move into a job within 6 months after finishing their education




Supply of apprenticeships

Introduce or intensify blended training methodologies



Capacitate their staff to deliver distance and online training by acquiring equipment, software and training relevant staff.



- Another <u>survey</u> also revealed that 72% of Europe's leading companies were planning to make more frequent use of blended learning in the next two years, making it the most preferred learning method in European workplaces.
