
# PARNERSHIP IN THE AUTOMOTIVE ECOSYSTEM WITHIN PACT FOR SKILLS

### AUTOMOTIVE SKILLS ALLIANCE (ASA)



The ASA mission is to bring together different kind of stakeholders involved in the Automotive ecosystem and to ensure **continuous**, **pragmatic and sustainable cooperation** on the skills agenda in the ecosystem.



It further aims to ensure collaboration on a **European level, as** well as on national and regional levels, between all the involved stakeholders in the Automotive ecosystem.

- Provide clear implementation framework towards skills transformation and contribute to post-COVID recovery
- Pave the way to member states/regions/industry for massive up-/re-skilling agenda (to be implemented ASAP)
- Jointly, with partners and the Commission, provide **one-stop-shop services** for members
- Represent an open partnership for all already existing or future stakeholders, initiatives or projects to cooperate under one European umbrella for the Automotive Ecosystem.

### **ASA - PARTNER ENGAGEMENT**

Establishment of a **skills partnership for the automotive ecosystem,** based on the stakeholder's joint call.

**Updated intelligence** about the automotive ecosystem and its development, as well as guidance to education and training bodies leading to continuous skills needs updates.

MASSIVE WORKFORCE UPSKILLING AND RESKILLING ACROSS THE AUTOMOTIVE ECOSYSTEM

**EU-wide framework for skills and job roles** building on DRIVES outcomes, as well as shared experience and best practices.

Platform for exchange of best practices and one-stop-shop guidance for the financial instruments available on European and national level for financing skills agenda.



### ASA – PACT FOR SKILLS LINK TO BLUEPRINT PROJECTS

- ASA builds upon the work carried out by strategic projects in the skills agenda for the ecosystem, and based on the Blueprint partnership collaborations, it will further broaden the outcomes of the key initiators such as - DRIVES (2018 - 2021), Blueprint project, which provides inputs to the future work of the partnership, and the ALBATTS (2019 - 2023) Blueprint project.
- DRIVES project provides Automotive Skills Agenda Strategy & Roadmap with clear indication of Key Actions for the sector, including the establishment of the Automotive Skills Alliance
- ASA will benefit from DRIVES and ALBATTS deliverables
  - DRIVES work on Automotive Skills Intelligence Strategy and Roadmap including also Sectoral Analysis of Skills Demand and Offer, Analysis and Recommendations focused on Apprenticeship in Automotive Sector
  - DRIVES Framework initial version of EU-wide database of reference job roles and training courses provided across Europe and possibility of digital badges for skills awards
  - DRIVES Job Roles and DRIVES MOOCs to offer directly to companies and also to education and training providers to their courses
  - ALBATTS analysis of the skills intelligence in the Batteries for Electromobility sector.
  - ALBATTS further work to be carried out regarding to specific educational and training offer for the battery sector





# **ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE**




### ASA – ORGANISATIONAL OVERVIEW & UPDATE




### ASA – CONTRIBUTION OF THE EC TO THE INDIVIDUAL WGs
