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National reforms in vocational education and training and adult learning

In November 2021, the Spanish government published a new law that regulates and updates the Spanish VET system including the assessment, promotion and qualification of the VET students. The reference point for the assessment in VET will be, as it was, the learning outcomes.

Basic vocational training: successful completion of all the subjects (modules) included in a basic VET course will lead to obtain the qualification in a professional field and the Graduate in Compulsory Secondary Education.

Vocational training (intermediate and higher): the assessment of students learning will be carried out by professional subjects (modules).

VET Specialization Courses (intermediate and higher): intended for people who have obtained a VET degree and wish to expand and adapt their professional skills to a constantly evolving labor market.

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The law establishes that all the micro-credentials are:

-accreditable: certified by a Learning Outcome

-accumulative (stackable)

-recognized: to support flexible learning pathways

The training offer is structured in a vertical way from micro-training to VET courses.

All the offers will allow progress in training itineraries leading to accreditations, recognition and qualifications with state and European recognition.

All the VET offers will be organised according to different levels: A to D
